That period of his life came to an end in 1933 when the Nazis came to power in Germany Brecht fled and during this period the Nazis removed his citizenship, so he was a stateless citizen In 1941 Brecht became resident in the USA but returned to Europe in 1947 after being accused of being anti-American By the time of his death in 1956, Brecht had established the Berliner Ensemble and was
