food waste compositional analysis

Most of the food we throw away (41 million tonnes or 61%) is avoidable and could have been eaten if it had been managed better Truly unavoidable food waste, like vegetable peelings, meat carcasses and teabags, accounts for 13 million tonnes a year or 19% of the total, with the remainder being 'possibly avoidable' food waste - items such as bread crusts that some people choose not to

Good Practice Guidance for Care Homes Expiry Dates Feb 11

1 Definition - The expiry date is the point in time when a pharmaceutical product is no longer within an acceptable condition to be considered effective The medication reaches the end of its 'shelflife' Depending on the product, the expiry date may be set as a fixed time

Flooding - Frequently Asked Health Questions

If your freezer has not been working throw away any food that has started to get soft, including food that is intended to be eaten from frozen (eg ice cream) Depending upon how full the freezer is, produce can remain frozen and safe for 24 hours or more if the freezer door is left unopened PHE advises the maxim "when in doubt throw it out"
